Is there a Doctor in the house?



Well yes there is! We'd like to welcome Dr Greg Butcher to our family practice who many will know formerly as Mr Greg Butcher our usual Audiologist. Greg has updated his skills over the last 2 years with an International Clinical Doctor of Audiology Degree undertaken from the Osborne College of Audiology, Salus University Philadelphia, the only College of Audiology in the United

States. Alongside theory exams, Greg also travelled overseas to attend workshops to complete the degree.

While a University Master's Degree (currently the highest hearing qualification in Australia) prepares the audiologist to learn the skills and techniques necessary to provide clinical services for the hearing impaired, the Salus University AuD program prepares audiologists to integrate evidence-based practice and advances in research into their own clinical practice. The advanced level post-masters courses are constructed towards advancing knowledge in the core areas of neurosciences, hearing science, diagnostic and rehabilitative technologies, clinical sciences, rehabilitation sciences and public health and professional issues.

There are two ways to earn a Doctorate - by way of a PhD which focusses primarily on academic research, or that of focussing on a chosen profession such as the Clinical Audiology Doctorate or AuD, involving both teaching and research.

Greg said one of the greatest things about the program was to work closely with world class clinicians and Professors of Audiology, sharing their knowledge and expertise. There are very few Audiologists in Australia that have taken up further education with this degree. Greg looks forward to working with his clients, using the curriculum which has focused on enhancing the breadth of knowledge in both the current trends and recent advances in the field of audiology around the world. Greg's graduating ceremony will take place in the city of Philadelphia USA in October this year.


What Happens in Normal Aging?

If buying hearing aids over the internet from websites such as Ebay or other website based businesses, you run the risk of
