


Audiology Services Second to None!

Did you know Accent Hearing has a fully qualified Doctor of Audiology (the only one in Northern NSW), who works in the field of non-medical issues of hearing?

Doctor Greg Butcher (AuD), an Accredited Member of Audiology Australia and also Independent Audiologists Australia, has been trained to identify hearing problems and to continue to help with rehabilitation programs for his clients to gain the best results in hearing their best. He also refers onto other medical specialists should he find a hearing assessment not in agreement with the life history or diagnostic results at the time of the assessment.

Greg, has on a numerous occasions over his Audiology career, insisted on further diagnosis from other medical



specialists through clients GP's. With this persistence, it has helped clients find early signs of slow growing benign vestibular Schwannomas or acoustic neuromas—a Schwannoma is a type of low-grade brain tumour that develops from schwann cells. Schwannoma and other types of brain tumours, large benign arachnoid cysts along with additional critical medical issues have also been diagnosed after a hearing test has been carried out. Some crucial diagnosis has immediately had some of Greg's clients on a course of anti-biotics, have undertaken surgery or have commenced steroids, chemotherapy or radiation treatment - some of which are life saving issues!

Qualified Audiologists are trained to look for results identifying **'red flags'** such as **roaring tinnitus** in one ear; overnight **sudden sensorineural hearing loss (SSHL); unexplained 'dizziness' or 'true vertigo' -**

- (which feels like the room is spinning); asymmetry between the ears (the hearing thresholds are quite different in each ear); to symptoms like continuous fluid draining from the ear (otorrhea) of even a leak of cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) from the nose. All these symptoms require further medical advice and explanations, as they are not normal.

Did you know?

If you are on the Hearing Services Program (www.hearingservices.gov.au), from 1 July 2021 you are now able to get a yearly appointment to check your hearing, even if you don't have hearing devices. Previously you were only eligible for a new hearing test every 3 years with or without devices. If you think your hearing has changed and it's been 12 months or more since you last had a hearing assessment, why not phone us to make an appointment.

Wax Problems?

Micro-suction is the preferred method to guarantee safe and effective removal of ear wax as well as other foreign bodies that may obstruct the ear canal. Cotton buds can sometimes make ear wax build up worse, so If you are not sure if you have



ear wax build up and need to have it removed, why not book in for a consultation.

Please note that an initial, investigative consultation may be required prior to performing the procedure. You will be asked a series of questions and sign a disclaimer in relation to your ear health before any procedure takes place.

*Please use a wax softener a few days before your appointment, available at our clinic or your local chemist. You can also pick up or call us for advice and instructions on using ear wax softener for 'effective use' to avoid extra appointments.
